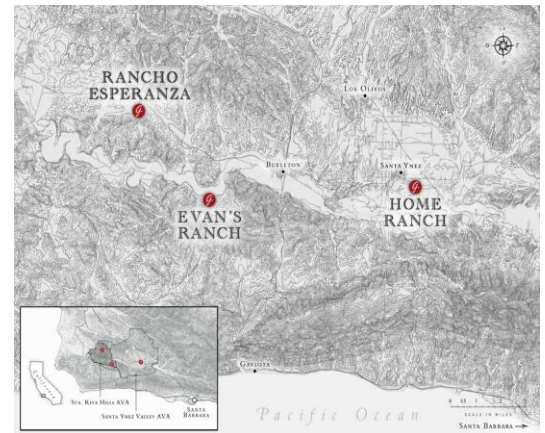
Gainey Vineyard – Three Ranches with John Falcone, General Manager Friday, January 17th, 2020 at 7:30 PM



Please join us for a night with John Falcone, long-time GM at Gainey Vineyard. John will walk us through a fabulous collection of wines from Gainey Family and friends! The Gainey family started their first ranch in the Santa Ynez Valley in 1962 including a cattle operation and farmland for vegetables, fruit, flowers, and hay. By 1984, the Gaineys had converted 50 acres of their “Home Ranch” to grapevines and established a Spanish-style winery to produce small quantities of high-quality wine including a Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Riesling, Pinot Noir, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon.

In 1996, fourth generation Dan Gainey purchased a plot of land in what would become the Santa Rita Hills appellation in western Santa Ynez Valley, and planted 60 acres of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Syrah. He named the vineyard Evan’s Ranch after his great-grandfather. The Sta. Rita Hills proved ideally suited to those varieties with its cool, maritime climate. In 2009, he planted another 50 acres in plot called Rancho Esperanza.

Each of the three Gainey ranches offers a unique combination of soil types, microclimate, sun exposure and grape varieties, ensuring great complexity in their wines. They grow warm climate varieties at the Home Ranch in the warmer, eastern end of Santa Ynez Valley and cool climate varieties at the Evan’s Ranch and Rancho Esperanza in the cool, marine-influenced Sta. Rita Hills appellation. All three ranches yield grapes of exceptional character, allowing them to craft 100% estate-grown wines. Controlling the process from vine to bottle ensures they maintain a consistently high level of quality.



For this event, John will guide us through a tasting of wine from the Gainey and Evans Ranch labels as well as a selection from his Falcone Family wines. We will start with a wonderful Chardonnay aperitif and follow that with three fabulous flights of Pinots Noir, Syrah, and Bordeaux varietals. In each flight, we will taste wines ranging from Estate to Limited selections, sourced from each of the three ranches and their distinct appellations.
