Dark Reds from the Moonlit Skies of Paso Robles with Rich Hartenberger of Midnight Cellars Winery

at the Crowne Plaza Redondo Beach

The Hartenberger family began Midnight Cellars in May of 1995. The original idea sprang from a family vacation to Northern California wine country in 1993. While sipping wine and overlooking a beautiful valley, the comment was made: "You know Dad, why don't you buy a winery when you retire & we'll run it for you."



A year later, in 1994, the winery idea resurfaced when "Dad," Robert Hartenberger, retired. The family members sold their Chicago homes and converged on Paso Robles. They found and purchased a beautiful, 160 acre, ranch near the Santa Lucia Mountains on the west side of Paso Robles.

The Midnight Estate vineyard, situated on 30 acres of hillside-hilltop terrain, is characterized by cool maritime influences and calcareous soils. The vineyard, currently planted to Chardonnay, Zinfandel, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec & Petit Verdot, produces approximately 7,000 cases of small production wines annually.

Rich Hartenberger, winemaker at Midnight Cellars, is the son of Mary Jane & Robert Hartenberger. Rich controls every aspect of the winemaking process from the vineyard to the bottle. He creates wines that are a reflection of the fruit from their vineyards situated in the Templeton Gap AVA on the west side of Paso Robles.



We'll taste a flight of whites, 2 scored 91 pts in Wine Enthusiasts, and 2 flights of red. The first red flight features single varietals including Rich's award winning Estate Merlot! The last flight features their limited production reserve wines, which many of us would call big blends. Have your chocolate on hand!!
