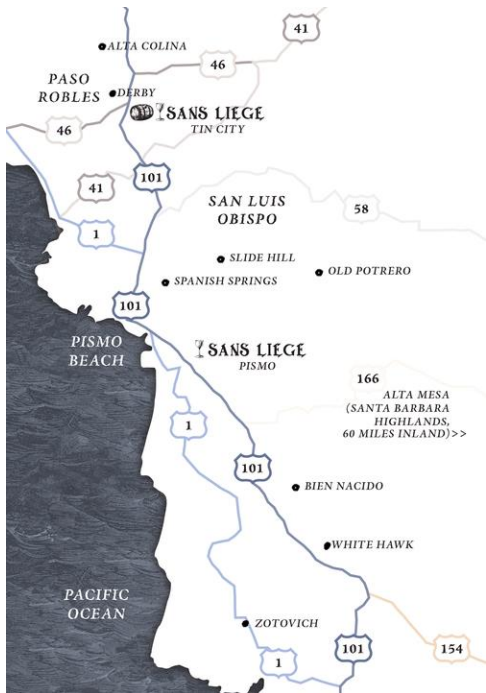




Space Park Enology Club Presents:
A Virtual Wine Tasting with
Curt Schalchlin of
Sans Liege Wines
Friday, March 12th, at 7:30 pm, via Zoom



The Space Park Enology Club is excited to welcome back Curt Schalchlin, Winemaker of Sans Liege and Groundworks Wines. Curt will lead us through a tasting and discussion of four of their highly rated Central Coast wines! Watch and listen via Zoom and sip along by ordering the discounted set of these 4 wines. Or if you prefer, you can join us on Zoom without purchasing these wines (but, why would you want to do that?)



California's Central Coast is home to a wide variety of climates, soils, and topographies, and well known for producing noteworthy Rhône varietals. Curt believes that his role as winemaker is to enable the grapes to tell their stories and that the wines will in turn tell his. When choosing vineyards to source fruit he searches for sites with a distinctive appeal that separates them from the rest. He has cultivated relationships with great vineyards throughout Santa Barbara and San Luis Obispo Counties; the wines we'll be tasting represent about a dozen of these vineyards. We'll be tasting:

- 2019 Cotes du Coast (Viogner, Roussane, Marsanne, Grenache Blanc, and Clairette)
- 2018 Offering (Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre)
- 2010 Groundwork Grenache (library wine)
- 2018 Groundwork Syrah

Sans Liege has extended a special discount to us, so each virtual attendee can order this 4-bottle shipment directly from the winery for only \$95.00 plus tax, about \$103 total, which includes overnight shipping via GSL. Los Angeles area wines will be shipped on Monday, March 8th so please place your order by Sunday, March 7th to ensure on-time delivery.
